

Pupil Premium Summary for Wilburton CE Primary School 2023-24

Purpose: The pupil premium grant is funding to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in state-funded schools in England.

£1455 = the amount of funding for each primary-aged pupil per year who is eligible for free school meals, or have been eligible in the past 6 years.

£2530 = the amount of funding for a pupil previously looked after by a local authority (including pupils who have been adopted from care)

£145 = the additional amount per free school meals pupil received through the Covid-19 'Recovery Premium'

25 pupils at Wilburton receive pupil premium funding (October 2023).

This is **22.5%**, which is similar to the national average.

The school's total funding for 2023-24 is £34, 675.

To ensure that pupil premium is focused on effective approaches to raising the educational attainment of disadvantaged pupils, schools must use their pupil premium in line with the 'menu of approaches' set by the Department for Education. This is how the school allocates this funding under these approaches:

1. Supporting high quality teaching for all

- Subscribing to the EYFS and Primary Offer support packages from the Local Authority, for support and training to drive improvement in the quality of teaching and learning.
- Funding staff training: CPD that helps to achieve school improvement plan aims.
- Phonics development days and training package.
- Funding programmes for school leaders.
- Supply costs to allow staff to attend CPD provided, e.g. maths mastery
- French curriculum subscription
- Maths Flex subscription for KS2
- Instrument tuition for Year 4

2. Targeted academic support

• Teaching Assistant hours to provide language intervention, phonics tutoring, reading, writing and maths support and interventions.

3. Tackling non-academic barriers to academic success

- 1 hour per week of Admin time to support attendance
- Financial support for children to attend school trips and for resources
- School milk
- Training to support mental wellbeing, e.g. Drawing and Talking
