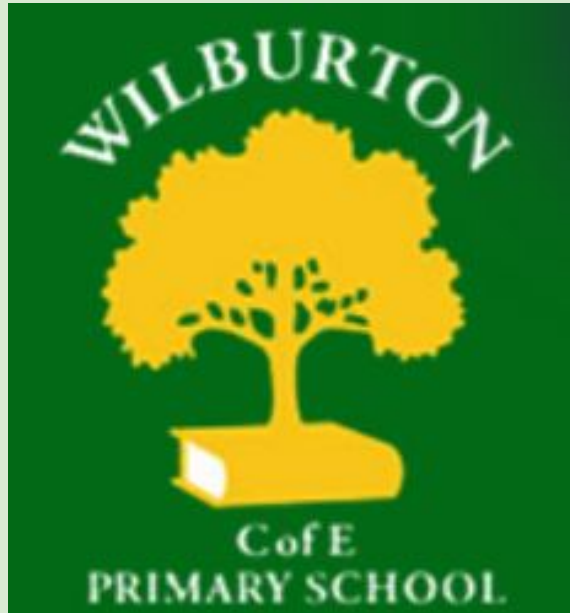


# Foxes Class - everything you need to know!

# Uniform

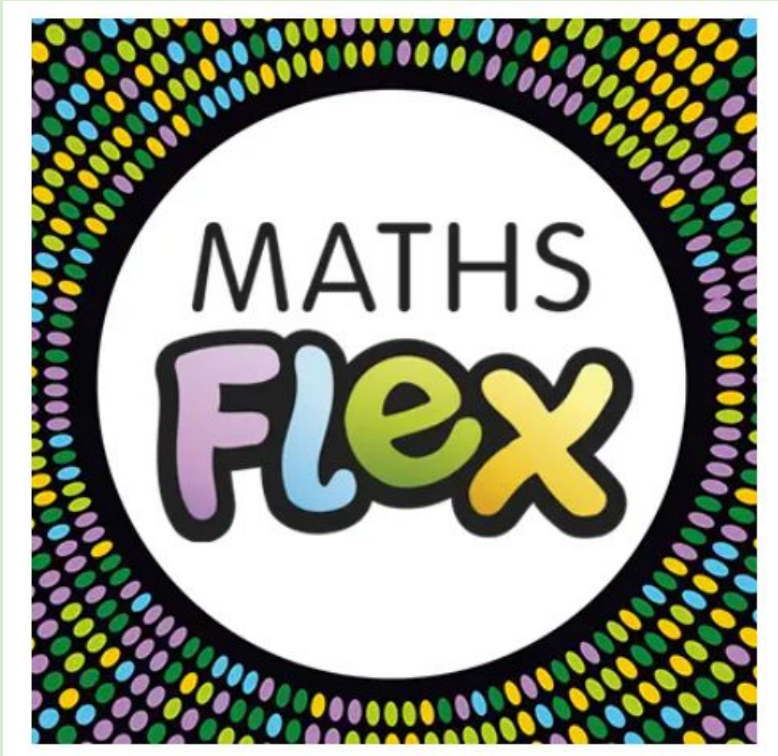
You will take home 5 common exception words (tricky words) each Friday. These will be tested in school on the following Friday.

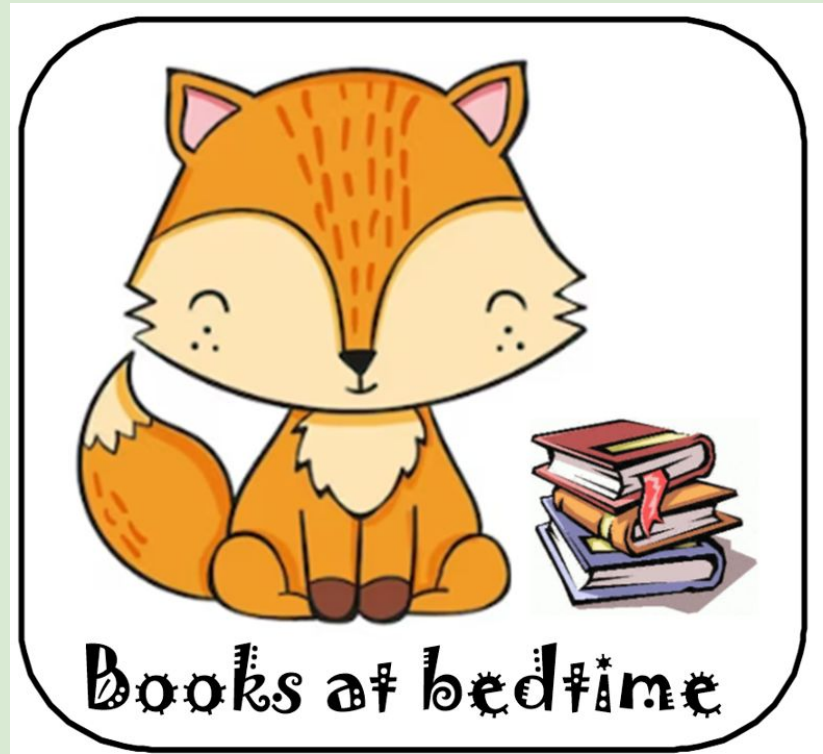
