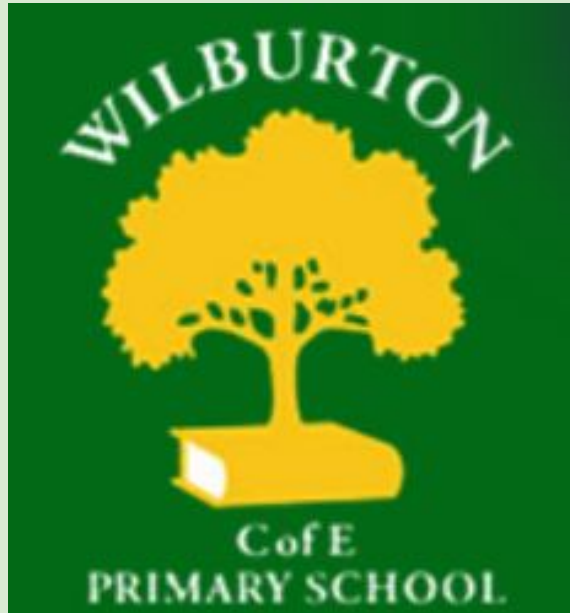


Hedgehogs Class - everything you need to know!

Uniform

PE

School PE kit is loose-fitting green shorts, a green t-shirt, black jogging bottoms and trainers. Leggings or tight-fitting shorts are not appropriate PE kit.

You can continue to wear your PE all day on PE days.

You cannot wear earrings during PE. They need to be removed and you need to be able to do this yourself.



Outdoor Curriculum

You need to be prepared to be outside in all weathers.

This means wearing comfortable shoes which you can run in; having a waterproof coat and wellies in school every day; wellies or walking boots and gardening gloves for the allotment; and having a water bottle in school everyday.



Forest School

Your forest school day will be **Wednesday** until half term.

You will be going offsite with Mrs Sykes.

You will need to wear long trousers and a long sleeve top (PE jogging bottoms and your school jumper are perfect); waterproofs (trousers and jacket); walking boots or wellies; and hats and gloves as the weather becomes colder.

Spelling - 5-10 words will be sent home on Fridays for you to learn. These will be tested the following Friday. The first list will be sent home this Friday.

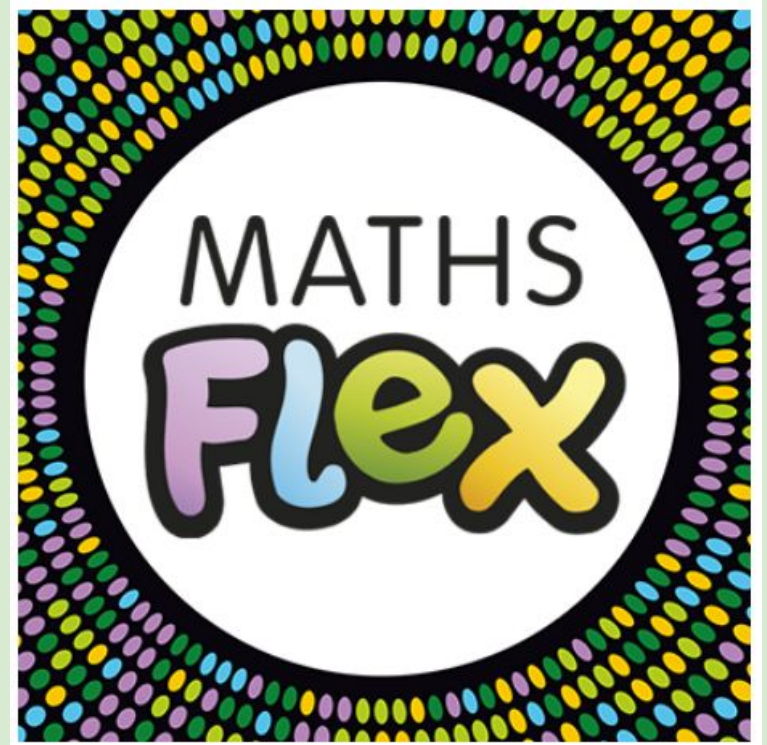
English - there will also be **online English homework**. Details to follow.
