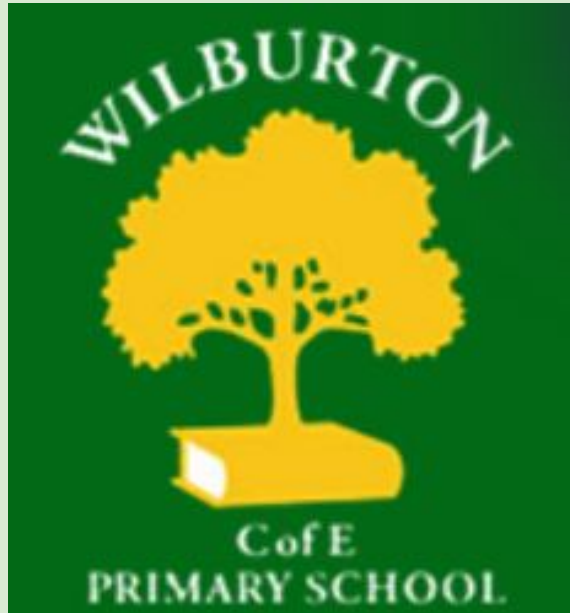

Uniform
