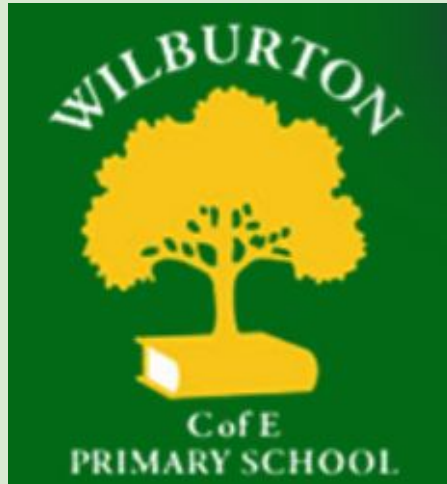


Owls Class - everything you need to know!

Uniform

Outdoor Curriculum

You need to be prepared to be outside in **all** weathers.

This means wearing comfortable shoes which you can run in; having a **waterproof coat** and **wellies** in school every day and having a water bottle in school everyday.

PE

Our PE days are **Monday and Thursday**.

School PE kit is loose-fitting green/black shorts, a green t-shirt, green sweatshirt, black jogging bottoms and trainers.

No leggings or tight-fitting shorts please.

On PE days you can come to school wearing your PE kit and stay in it all day.

You cannot wear earrings during PE.

Please don't wear earrings on PE days or Forest School days.

A selection of tasks to promote fluency in the four operations with a focus on multiplication and division.

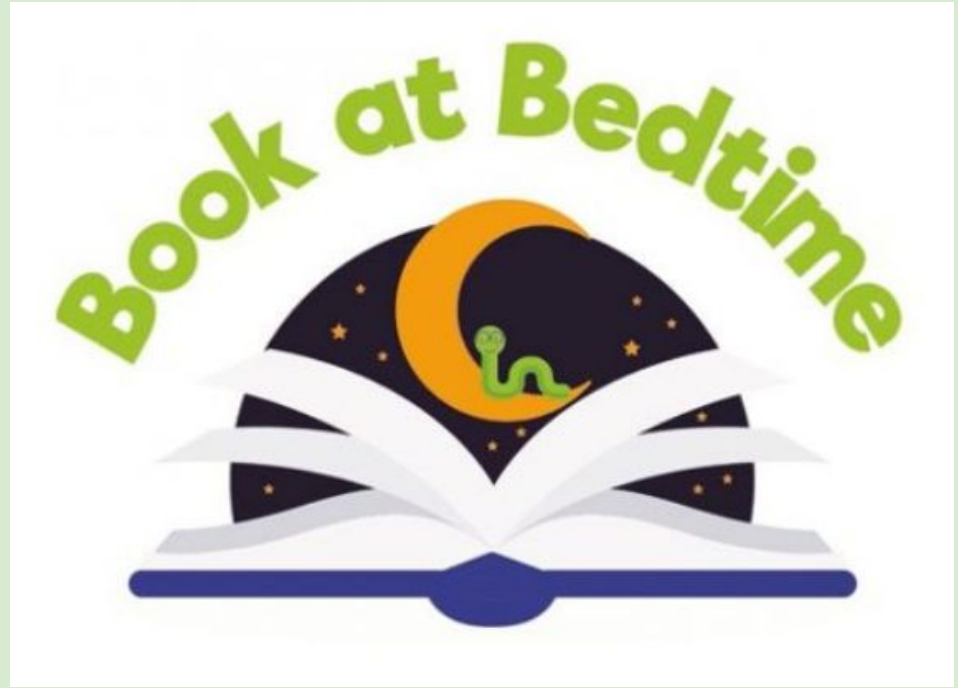
These tasks may take the form of games, worksheets or online activities. Rapid recall of facts is vital for progression in maths and these activities are important.

Children will be expected to catch up any missed homework in their own time in school.
